## Executive Summary

Since 2022, Innovatia has partnered with a national public-sector financial institution to support a critical operational transition: bringing the administration of retail debt products in-house after years of outsourced delivery. This transition required the organization to rapidly build internal capability while maintaining continuity, accuracy, and compliance within a highly regulated environment.

Innovatia designed and delivered a comprehensive learning and documentation ecosystem to enable operational readiness across system proficiency, product knowledge, and specialized processing workflows—the program equipped end users to confidently administer a broad portfolio of retail debt and consumer financial instruments.

Delivered on schedule and at scale, the engagement resulted in high-end user and stakeholder satisfaction, flawless execution across a complex timeline, and an ongoing partnership that continues through post-launch updates and new initiatives. In addition to enabling launch readiness, the initiative supported modernizing the organization's knowledge management approach, strengthening long-term sustainability and engagement.

## The Challenge

The client faced a high-risk operational shift: assuming full internal responsibility for administering retail debt products previously managed by a third-party provider. This transition required replacing external expertise with internal capability without disrupting service delivery or compromising regulatory and governance requirements.



To achieve operational readiness, end users needed to be upskilled across multiple dimensions simultaneously:



Proficiency with a newly implemented retail debt administration platform



Product knowledge across a diverse set of retail debt and consumer financial instruments



Consistent execution of specialized, end-to-end operational workflows

The organization required more than standalone training materials. It needed a structured, scalable, and sustainable learning and knowledge ecosystem capable of supporting both implementation readiness and ongoing operations.

## The Solution

Innovatia partnered closely with the client to design and deliver an end-to-end learning and documentation program aligned with both immediate implementation requirements and long-term operational needs.

## Strategic Foundation

The engagement began with the development of a High-Level Design Document defining program objectives, scope, learning strategy, governance structures, and an implementation roadmap. This foundation ensured alignment across stakeholders and established a clear direction for the initiative.

## Comprehensive Operational Documentation

Innovatia developed 120 procedures and guidelines covering the full lifecycle of retail debt administration activities. These resources established consistency, accuracy, and confidence as internal teams assumed responsibility for previously outsourced operations.

## Workflow Support Tools

To support day-to-day execution, Innovatia designed **12 standardized operational forms** aligned with system workflows and compliance requirements.

## Immersive, Scenario-Based Learning

Innovatia created **20 hours of Training Workbooks** incorporating realistic, scenario-based activities. These learning assets enabled end users to practice real-world tasks in a controlled environment, building competence and confidence before launch.

## Knowledge Infrastructure Enablement

As part of the engagement, Innovatia supported the transition from legacy document storage to a centralized enterprise knowledge platform. This shift improved knowledge accessibility, usability, and engagement, enabling scalable and sustainable knowledge management beyond the initial system implementation.

Innovatia met 100% of interim and final milestones across a complex, multi-phase engagement.




The Training Workbooks were recognized by stakeholders as the most effective learning assets produced during the initiative.
